2020, 2021 and 2022 have been quite a ride. We came through it without having Covid in any of our camps, knock on wood. Our biggest event in the last 3 years was taking the largest Dall ram harvested since 1984, ranking 6th all-time in the Boone and Crockett record book with an official score of 184 1/8. Most of our game populations are stable and doing well. Our hunters are enjoying very high success rates on all species, and have worked very hard to achieve their goals. We will work hard to continue this into the years ahead, and achieve our goal of having all our hunters be happy and successful.

Sheep: 2020 was a great year. We had the new number 6 all time Dall sheep, scoring 184 1/8, on the ground on opening day. We knew this ram was big, but we had no idea he was that big. We had been watching this ram for 3 years. This was the first year he was full curl, thank goodness, or he would never have lived to be 11 years old. Overall, we went 4 for 4 on rams and they all officially scored 160 7/8 or better B&C. Their horn lengths were 42 7/8, 39 6/8, 39 5/8 and 37 7/8 for an average of 40 inches. Their average age was 11.

2021: We went 7 for 9 on rifle rams, and had a bow hunter that missed a long, awkward shot. Of the 2 rifle hunters that didn't harvest, one was 68 years old and was physically limited. They worked very hard and several times came very close to getting a shot, but just had some bad luck and some unfortunate circumstances. The other hunter had a late season hunt and was in the best physical condition of any of our hunters, ever. They covered every inch of their area but could not find a legal ram. 5 of the rams scored over 160 and one made the all-time B&C record book at 172 2/8. Their 7 horn lengths were 43, 40 4/8, 39 5/8, 38 6/8, 38 5/8, 37 5/8 and 37 for an average of 39 2/8.

2022: We went 6 for 7 on rifle rams and had a bow hunter that didn't get a shot. The one hunter missed a nice ram twice and we were unable to get on another one before they had to leave. All 6 rams had B&C green scores of 160 or better. One officially scored 170 B&C and just made it in the all-time record book. Their horn lengths were 42 1/8, 39 6/8, 39 6/8, 39 3/8, 39 and 37 5/8 for an average of 39 5/8.

Our sheep populations in the Chugach are stable. There aren't large numbers of mature rams but there are so few permits that there isn't much pressure, and we can always find enough mature rams for our hunters.

Alaska Peninsula Brown Bear: In 2020 we didn't have a season because of the lock down. In 2021 we had spring and fall seasons. We went 3 for 3 on our spring bears, all were giant old boars. They squared 10'1", 10" and 9'8". Their skulls scored SCI 28 14/16, 28 13/16 and 28 7/16. We went 4 for 5 on fall bears. One hunter could only hunt 5 days, we had a big storm, the bears were scarce in the area he was hunting and it didn't happen. The 4 bears we took squared 9'8", 9'3", 9'3" and 9'1". The biggest skull was 26 14/16. We are seeing a lot more younger 8 1/2' to 9' boars now, so the future looks bright. In 2022 we had a spring season. We had 2 hunters and it was cold and slow. We saw bears everyday but no 10 footers. One hunter had family affairs to attend to after 6 days and the other hunter was holding out for a 10 footer. He shot a 9'2" boar, which they thought was bigger, on the 2nd to the last day.

Mt. Goats: Our goats are doing well with high numbers of mature billies. We don't shoot nannies. We went 3 for 3 on billies in 2020. One was an ancient 12 year old. Their horn lengths were 9 2/8, 9 1/8 and 9 1/8. In 2021 we went 3 for 5 on billies. We had really terrible weather, which scattered the goats more than usual. One hunter missed a big billy twice because of a range miscalculation and the other had bad luck with the wind, weather and some fickle goats. We tried to get them to stay but they both had to leave for work obligations after their week was up. The 3 billies had horn lengths of 9 7/8, 9 7/8 and 8 5/8. In 2022 we went 4 for 4 on billies and had them all on the ground on opening day. Their horn lengths were 9 6/8, 9 2/8, 9 1/8 and 8 6/8 and they were 5 to 7 years old.

Moose: We have been 100% on our moose for the last 3 years, going 7 for 7 in that time. We lost some old bulls last winter and we had to hunt really hard to get the 2 we got in 2022. In 2020 we took 2 bulls, both in the low 50s. In 2021 we took 3 bulls with spreads of 60", 62' and 65 4/8". They B&C green scored between 210 and 224. In 2022 we went 2 for 2 with spreads of 58" and 62".

Grizzly and Black bear over bait: We didn't have a season in 2020 because of the Covid lock-down. We took a nice old grizzly in 2021 and a few black bears. In 2022 I only took one hunter. We had a scope malfunction, shot one black bear and wounded two, and he decided to call it quits before we had a chance at a grizzly.

A big shout out to all of our hunters for working hard and giving it their all. A very grateful THANK YOU to all of our crew for doing a great job, resulting in a lot of happy and successful hunters in these stressful years. Well done, Nolan, Rick, Mark, TJ, Mike G., Mike P., Jordan, Aaron, Thys, Evan, Hank F., Hunter, Branden and Cory, you guys are awesome. —**Dan and Loren and Hank**
