LIST OF ITEMS TO BRING WITH YOU BROWN BEAR HUNTERS

Synthetic Sleeping Bag – rated to at least 0 degrees F
Sleeping pad or air mattress – closed cell or Thermarest type (must be waterproof)
LED Head Lamp, with 12 hrs. minimum burn time (Black Diamond)
1 Set of Extra Batteries
30 Caliber Magnum Rifle or Larger
2 Boxes Ammo
Binoculars – At least 8x to 10x
Digital Camera
Knife – Havalon Piranta with 5ea. model 60A blades
External Frame Pack, (Outdoor Gear of Alaska, Barney's Sport Chalet type), or large
Internal Frame Pack (Stone Glacier Type)
Personal Hygiene Items

CLOTHING – Most of the Sitka or Kuiu gear is very good.
All Outer Clothes should be Fleece or High Tech Synthetic

2 Pair Gloves with grip palms and fingers, Avoid waterproof gloves, won't dry out
1 pair Outdoor Research Shuksan Waterproof Over Mitts
2 Hats (1 baseball style, 1 stocking or fleece hat)
2 Heavy Shirts
1 Light Shirt
1 Warm heavy Coat and 1 light Jacket
2 Pair of Pants
6 Pair Heavy Boot Socks (Smart Wool, Cabela's or Darn Tough)
4 Pair liner Polypropylene Socks
4 Pair Underwear
2 Pair Polypropylene Long Underwear
2 Polypropylene Long Sleeve Tee Shirts
Quality Rain Jacket with hood & Pants –with good pair of suspenders for pants – Kuiu
Yukon or Helly Hansen Impertech in camo preferred)
2 pair stirrup fleece wader pants. (Cabela's)

SHOES and WADERS

1 Pair Leather Hiking Boots – by Meindl, Schnee's or Crispi preferred
1 Pair Camp Shoes (slip on – waterproof, L.L.BEAN)
1 Pair Stocking Foot Breathable Chest Waders w/lug sole Wading Boots
1 Pair Knee High Rubber Boots (Bear Hunters) – Optional
